- 1. content (adj): satisified, happy, wanting nothing more
- 2. rarely (adv): infrequently; not often
- 3. asset (noun): a help/aid; a needed, useful, valuable person or thing
- 4. slouch (verb): bend over; to sit/stand in a drooping way
- 5. madras (adj or noun): a piece of cloth having a plaid, striped or checked pattern
- 6. cowlick (noun): a piece or pieces of hair that stick up in a direction different from the rest of the hair
- 7. quivering (adj): shaking repeatedly
- 8. sarcasm (noun): cutting or ironic remark intended to hurt; form of wit that ridicules
- 9. incredulous (adj): disbelieving; skeptical
- 10. nonchalantly (adv): acting like or doing something without care; indifferently
- 11. sophisticated (adj): knowledgeable about the ways of the world and self-confident; complex, advanced
- 12. elite (adj): aristocratic, rich, affluent, upper or high class
- 13. resignedly (adv): in a way that suggests giving up
- 14. unceasingly (adv): never-ending, continually, indefinitely
- 15. bootleg (adj or noun): to make or sell illegally copied, made or recorded goods or material, originally referring to alcohol/liquor
